A BILL

To amend the National Voter Registration Act of 1993 to increase the criminal penalties under such Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Securing Our Elections
5 Act of 2020”.

6 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF CRIMINAL PENALTY FOR TAM-**
7 **PERING WITH OR INTERFERING IN AN ELEC-**
8 **TION FOR FEDERAL OFFICE.**

9 Section 12 of the National Voter Registration Act of
10 1993 (52 U.S.C. 20511) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “fined in accordance with title
2 18, United States Code,” and inserting “fined not
3 more than \$100,000”; and

4 (2) by striking “imprisoned not more than 5
5 years” and inserting “imprisoned not less than 5
6 years and not more than 15 years”.

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
