A BILL

To provide clarification with respect to the effective date of Medicare coverage of COVID–19 vaccines without any cost-sharing.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ensuring Access to
5 COVID–19 Vaccines for Seniors Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE OF MEDICARE COVERAGE OF** 7 **COVID–19 VACCINES WITHOUT ANY COST-** 8 **SHARING.**
