A BILL

To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to extend by one year certain port of entry donation authorities, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Funding for Infra-
5 structure at Ports of Entry Extension Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. ONE-YEAR EXTENSION OF CERTAIN PORT OF ENTRY**
7 **DONATION AUTHORITIES.**

8 Section 482(b) of the Homeland Security Act of 2002
9 (6 U.S.C. 301a(b)) is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (2), in the matter preceding
2 subparagraph (A), by striking “existing a” and in-
3 serting “existing”; and

4 (2) in paragraph (4)(A), by striking “the date
5 that is 4 years after December 16, 2016” and in-
6 serting “December 16, 2021”.

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
