- 8 (1) MAP.—The term "map" means the map en-

- 3 (2) Park.—The term "Park" means the Ken-
- 4 nesaw Mountain National Battlefield Park.
- 5 (3) SECRETARY.—The term "Secretary" means
- 6 the Secretary of the Interior.

7 SEC. 3. KENNESAW MOUNTAIN NATIONAL BATTLEFIELD

- 8 PARK BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT.
- 9 (a) BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT.—The boundary of the
- 10 Park is modified to include the approximately 8 acres of
- 11 land or interests in land identified as "Wallis House and
- 12 Harriston Hill", as generally depicted on the map.
- 13 (b) MAP.—The map shall be on file and available for
- 14 inspection in the appropriate offices of the National Park
- 15 Service.
- 16 (c) Land Acquisition.—The Secretary may acquire
- 17 land or interests in land described in subsection (a) by
- 18 donation, purchase from willing sellers, or exchange.
- 19 (d) Administration of Acquired Land.—The
- 20 Secretary shall administer land and interests in land ac-
- 21 quired under this Act as part of the Park in accordance
