Mr. PAUL introduced the following joint resolution; which was read twice and
referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to the disapproval of the proposed sale to the Gov-
ernment of Bahrain of certain defense articles and serv-
ices.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the issuance of a letter of offer with respect to any
4 of the following proposed sales to the Government of Bah-
5 rain (described in the certification Transmittal No. 18–
6 20, sent to the Speaker of the House of Representatives
7 and the chairman of the Committee on Foreign Relations
8 of the Senate pursuant to section 36(b)(1) of the Arms
9 Export Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2776(b)(1)) on May 6,
10 2019), is hereby prohibited:
