AN ACT

To amend title 38, United States Code, to extend eligibility for a certain work-study allowance paid by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to certain individuals who pursue programs of rehabilitation, education, or training on at least a half-time basis, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Student Veteran Work
5 Study Modernization Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PILOT PROGRAM TO EXPAND ELIGIBILITY FOR A**
7 **CERTAIN WORK-STUDY ALLOWANCE PAID BY**
8 **THE SECRETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS TO**
9 **CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS WHO PURSUE CER-**
10 **TAIN PROGRAMS ON AT LEAST A HALF-TIME**
11 **BASIS.**

12 (a) PILOT PROGRAM.—The Secretary of Veterans Af-
13 fairs shall carry out a pilot program under which the Sec-
14 retary shall expand eligibility for the work-study allowance
15 under section 3485 of title 38, United States Code, to in-
16 dividuals who are pursuing programs of rehabilitation,
17 education, or training specified in subsection (b) of such
18 section at a rate equal to at least half of that required
19 of a full-time student.

20 (b) RELATIONSHIP TO OTHER WORK-STUDY INDIV-
21 VIDUALS.—In carrying out the pilot program under sub-
22 section (a), the Secretary shall ensure the provisions of
23 section 3485 of title 38, United States Code, apply with
24 respect to the individuals specified in subsection (a) of this
25 section in the same manner as to the individuals specified

1 in subsection (b) of such section 3485, except with respect
2 to the requirement of at least three-quarter-time student
3 status.

4 (c) DURATION.—The Secretary shall carry out the
5 pilot program under subsection (a) during the five-year
6 period beginning on the date of the commencement of the
7 pilot program.

8 **SEC. 3. ANNUAL REPORT REGARDING VETERANS WHO PAR-**
9 **TICIPATE IN WORK-STUDY.**

10 Not later than 180 days after the date of the enact-
11 ment of this Act and annually thereafter, the Secretary
12 of Veterans Affairs shall submit to the Committees on
13 Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and House of Representa-
14 tives a report regarding veterans who participate in work-
15 study. Such report shall include the following elements:

16 (1) The number of such veterans.

17 (2) The percentage of such veterans who obtain
18 a four-year degree.

19 (3) The number of such veterans who obtain
20 full-time work at the Department of Veterans Af-
21 fairs.

22 **SEC. 4. ADJUSTMENTS OF CERTAIN LOAN FEES.**

23 The loan fee table in section 3729(b)(2) of title 38,
24 United States Code, is amended by striking “January 14,

1 2031” each place it appears and inserting “January 23,
2 2031”.

3 **SEC. 5. DETERMINATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.**

4 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of
5 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,
6 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
7 titled “Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation” for this
8 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record
9 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-
10 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the
11 vote on passage.
