Mr. HAWLEY introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs

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## A BILL

To clarify the jurisdiction of the Special Inspector General for Pandemic Recovery, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. JURISDICTION OF THE SPECIAL INSPECTOR**

4                       **GENERAL FOR PANDEMIC RECOVERY.**

5       Section 4018(c)(1) of the CARES Act (15 U.S.C.  
6       9053(c)(1)) is amended by striking “this Act” each place  
7       that term appears and inserting “this division”.

8       **SEC. 2. APPROPRIATIONS.**

9       (a) IN GENERAL.—In addition to amounts otherwise  
10      available, there is appropriated to the Special Inspector

1 General for Pandemic Recovery, out of amounts in the  
2 Treasury not otherwise appropriated, \$25,000,000 for  
3 each of fiscal years 2022 through 2025 to carry out the  
4 provisions of section 4018 of the CARES Act (15 U.S.C.  
5 9053), as amended by section 1 of this Act.

6 (b) EMERGENCY DESIGNATION.—

7 (1) IN GENERAL.—The amounts appropriated  
8 under this section are designated as an emergency  
9 requirement pursuant to section 4(g) of the Statu-  
10 tory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010 (2 U.S.C. 933(g)).

11 (2) DESIGNATION IN SENATE.—In the Senate,  
12 subparagraph (A) is designated as an emergency re-  
13 quirement pursuant to section 4112(a) of H. Con.  
14 Res. 71 (115th Congress), the concurrent resolution  
15 on the budget for fiscal year 2018.

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
