A BILL

To amend the Global Magnitsky Human Rights Accountability Act to extend the sunset for sanctions with respect to human rights violations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Global Magnitsky
5 Human Rights Accountability Extension Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF SANCTIONS WITH RESPECT**
7 **TO HUMAN RIGHTS VIOLATIONS.**

8 Section 1265 of the Global Magnitsky Human Rights
9 Accountability Act (Subtitle F of title XII of Public Law

1 114–328; 22 U.S.C. 2656 note) is amended by striking
2 “the date that is 6 years after the date of the enactment
3 of this Act” and inserting “December 31, 2034”.

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
