A BILL

To amend Public Law 99–420 to provide for the conveyance of certain Federal land in the State of Maine for use for affordable workforce housing, and for other purposes.

4 Section 102(f) of Public Law 99–420 (16 U.S.C. 341
 5 note) is amended by striking “which so desires” in the
 6 first sentence and all that follows through the period at
 7 the end of paragraph (2) and inserting the following: “that
 8 requests the conveyance of the land for affordable work-
 9 force housing, subject to the limitation that the Secretary
 10 may retain not more than 15 acres of the Federal land
 11 identified as ‘4DBH’ on the map, to be used by the Sec-
 12 retary to provide housing and administrative facilities for
 13 the use of, and supporting the purposes of, the Park.”.

17 *Section 102(f) of Public Law 99–420 (16 U.S.C. 341*

 19 *sires” in the first sentence and all that follows through the*
 20 *period at the end of paragraph (2) and inserting the fol-*
 21 *lowing: “for affordable workforce housing to benefit the*
 22 *towns on Mount Desert Island, subject to the limitation that*
 23 *the Secretary may retain not more than 15 acres of the*
 24 *Federal land identified as ‘4DBH’ on the map, to be used*
 25 *by the Secretary to provide housing and administrative fa-*

- 1 *cilities for the use of, and supporting the purposes of, the*
- 2 *Park.”.*

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
