A BILL

To limit the authority of the World Health Organization on the United States and to oppose amendments to the WHO Constitution that have not been approved by Congress.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION.**

4 (a) EFFECT OF WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION DI-
5 RECTIVES AND ORDERS ON THE UNITED STATES.—Not-
6 withstanding any other provision of law, the United States
7 shall not be bound by any directive or order issued by the

1 World Health Assembly, the World Health Organization,
2 or any agent or branch of the World Health Organization.

3 (b) OPPOSITION TO AMENDMENTS TO THE CON-
4 STITUTION OF THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION AND
5 ANY OTHER AGREEMENTS AMONG MEMBER STATES
6 WITHOUT CONGRESSIONAL APPROVAL.—The Secretary of
7 Health and Human Services and any other United States
8 official designated by the President to represent the
9 United States at the World Health Organization in any
10 capacity shall use the voice, vote, and influence of the
11 United States to oppose any amendments to the Constitu-
12 tion of the World Health Organization and any other
13 agreements among the member states unless Congress has
14 enacted a joint resolution in support of such amendments.

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
