3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Keeping Our Commit-
5 ment to Ending Veteran Homelessness Act of 2022”.

2 **ANCE FOR SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR VERY**

8 **SEC. 3. EXTENSION OF PROGRAM FOR HOMELESS SERV-**
9 **ICES AT ADDITIONAL LOCATIONS.**

10 Section 2033(d) of title 38, United States Code, is
11 amended by striking “September 30, 2022” and inserting
12 “September 30, 2024”.
