3 **SECTION 1. APPALACHIAN DEVELOPMENT HIGHWAY SYS-**  
4 **TEM.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 14501(a) of title 40,  
6 United States Code, is amended, in the second sentence,

1 by striking “three thousand and ninety miles” and insert-  
2 ing “3,105 miles”.

3 (b) PURPOSE.—The increase in mileage to the Appa-  
4 lachian Development Highway System made by the  
5 amendment made by subsection (a) shall be for improve-  
6 ments to and expansion of Corridor K in North Carolina.

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
