A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to require certain notice requirements by law enforcement officers of the Environmental Protection Agency before executing and serving warrants.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. POWERS OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTEC-**
4 **TION AGENCY.**

5 Section 3063 of title 18, United States Code, is
6 amended—

7 (1) in subsection (a)—

8 (A) by striking paragraph (1); and

1 (B) by redesignating paragraphs (2) and
2 (3) as paragraphs (1) and (2), respectively; and
3 (2) by adding at the end the following:
4 “(c) The guidelines approved under subsection (b)
5 shall require that a law enforcement officer described in
6 subsection (a) provide notice to appropriate State and
7 local law enforcement agencies before executing and serv-
8 ing any warrant.”.

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
