CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the rotunda of the Capitol for a ceremony to award posthumously a Congressional Gold Medal in commemoration to the servicemembers who perished in Afghanistan on August 26, 2021, during the evacuation of citizens of the United States and Afghan allies at Hamid Karzai International Airport.

1 **SECTION 1. USE OF ROTUNDA FOR CEREMONY TO AWARD**
 2 **POSTHUMOUSLY CONGRESSIONAL GOLD**
 3 **MEDAL IN COMMEMORATION TO**
 4 **SERVICEMEMBERS WHO PERISHED IN AF-**
 5 **GHANISTAN ON AUGUST 26, 2021, DURING**
 6 **EVACUATION OF UNITED STATES CITIZENS**
 7 **AND AFGHAN ALLIES AT HAMID KARZAI**
 8 **INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.**

9 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—The rotunda of the Capitol is
 10 authorized to be used on September 10, 2024, for a cere-
 11 mony to award posthumously a Congressional Gold Medal
 12 in commemoration to the servicemembers who perished in
 13 Afghanistan on August 26, 2021, during the evacuation
 14 of citizens of the United States and Afghan allies at
 15 Hamid Karzai International Airport.

16 (b) PREPARATIONS.—Physical preparations for the
 17 conduct of the ceremony described in subsection (a) shall
 18 be carried out in accordance with such conditions as the
 19 Architect of the Capitol may prescribe.
