A BILL

To amend the Consumer Product Safety Act to increase reliance by the Consumer Product Safety Commission on voluntary consumer product safety standards, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Consumer Product
5 Sanity Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCREASING RELIANCE BY COMMISSION ON VOL-**
2 **UNTARY CONSUMER PRODUCT SAFETY**
3 **STANDARDS.**

4 Section 7(b) of the Consumer Product Safety Act (15
5 U.S.C. 2056(b)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
6 lowing:

7 “(3) In any case in which the Commission determines
8 that compliance with a voluntary consumer product safety
9 standard would eliminate or adequately reduce the risk of
10 injury addressed, but determines substantial compliance
11 with such voluntary standard is not likely, the Commission
12 may promulgate a consumer product safety standard ad-
13 dressing such risk of injury only if—

14 “(A) such consumer product safety standard is
15 identical to such voluntary standard; or

16 “(B) in the case of a consumer product safety
17 standard that allows for compliance in more than
18 one manner, at least one such manner of compliance
19 is identical to such voluntary standard.”.

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
