Mr. POSEY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to require Members of Congress to disclose business ties with foreign entities, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Congressional Foreign
5 Entanglement Disclosure and Reduction Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DISCLOSURE BY MEMBERS OF CONGRESS OF BUSI-**
7 **NESS TIES WITH FOREIGN ENTITIES.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 13104 of title 5, United
9 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
10 lowing:

1 “(j) FOREIGN ENTITY BUSINESS TIES OF MEMBERS
2 OF CONGRESS.—Any report filed pursuant to section
3 13103(d) by a Member of Congress shall include the dis-
4 closure of any business ties the Member or any member
5 of the Member’s immediate family has (if any) with a for-
6 eign entity. If a Member of Congress makes an affirmative
7 disclosure of any such ties, the Member shall include infor-
8 mation detailing the nature of the business tie, the name
9 of the applicable foreign entity, and the total value of any
10 income received by the Member or immediate family mem-
11 ber as a result of such tie during the calendar year covered
12 by the report submitted pursuant to such section 13103(d)
13 and the preceding four calendar years.”.

14 (b) APPLICATION.—The amendment made by sub-
15 section (a) shall apply to any report filed pursuant to sec-
16 tion 13103(d) of title 5, United States Code, after the date
17 of enactment of this Act.

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
