A BILL

To rename the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch
Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RENAMING OF RICHARD B. RUSSELL NATIONAL**
4 **SCHOOL LUNCH ACT.**
