A BILL

To prohibit the obligation or expenditure of Federal funds for certain forms that offer an option other than Male or Female to reference the sex of an individual, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “There are Two Sexes
5 Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. NO OBLIGATION OR EXPENDITURE OF FEDERAL**
2 **FUNDS FOR CERTAIN FORMS THAT OFFER AN**
3 **OPTION OTHER THAN MALE OR FEMALE TO**
4 **REFERENCE THE SEX OF AN INDIVIDUAL.**

5 (a) PROHIBITION.—No Federal funds may be obli-
6 gated or expended for the creation or dissemination of a
7 form required to be signed by an individual under a Fed-
8 eral law or regulation that offers an option other than
9 Male or Female to reference the sex of the individual.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The prohibition under sub-
11 section (a) shall take effect on October 1, 2024.
