Mr. ROUZER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

To require the Comptroller General of the United States to conduct a study to evaluate any adverse effects of electric vehicles on United States infrastructure, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. STUDY ON ELECTRIC VEHICLES.**

4 The Comptroller General of the United States shall
5 conduct a study to evaluate any adverse effects of electric
6 vehicles, including, but not limited to, adverse effects of
7 electric vehicles on United States infrastructure integrity,
8 grid security, fire safety issues (including issues associated

1 with such vehicles and the charging of such vehicles), and
2 the labor market (including slave labor in China and in
3 other countries), and any adverse implications for Amer-
4 ican competitiveness.

5 **SEC. 2. USE OF STUDY FINDINGS.**

6 After the Comptroller General completes the study
7 required under section 1, any legislation considered by ei-
8 ther chamber of Congress addressing the use of electric
9 vehicles shall include a provision describing how the find-
10 ings of the study are taken into consideration in such leg-
11 islation.

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
