3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ensuring Distance
5 Education Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. TREATMENT OF REVENUE FROM CERTAIN DIS-**
2 **TANCE EDUCATION PROGRAMS FOR PUR-**
3 **POSES OF THE 90/10 RULE.**

4 Section 487(d)(1)(B)(iii) of the Higher Education
5 Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1094(d)(1)(B)(iii)) is amended by
6 inserting “(which may include funds paid for a program
7 offered in whole or in part through distance education re-
8 gardless of the location from which such program is car-
9 ried out)” after “under this title”.

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
