2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MAXIMUM MONTHLY ALLOWANCES OF MILK**
4 **UNDER WIC.**

5 Section 17 of the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42
6 U.S.C. 1786) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
7 lowing:

1 “(t) MAXIMUM MONTHLY ALLOWANCES OF MILK.—

2 The maximum monthly allowances of milk for the fol-
3 lowing food packages described in section 246.10(e) of
4 title 7, Code of Federal Regulations are:

5 “(1) For Food Package IV, 16 quarts.

6 “(2) For Food Package V, 22 quarts.

7 “(3) For Food Package VI, 22 quarts.

8 “(4) For Food Package VII, 24 quarts.”.

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
