who competed in the 2024 Olympics and Paralympics
in Paris, France.

Whereas the United States participants of the 2024 Paris
Olympics and Paralympics honored the Nation through
their dedication and patriotism;

Whereas 46 States are represented on Team USA, and 203
National Olympic Committees are represented across the
globe;

Whereas the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee
(USOPC) saw 637 athletes in Paris;

Whereas the Olympic symbol expresses the activity of the Olympic Movement and represents the union of the five continents and the meeting of athletes from throughout the world at the Olympic and Paralympic Games;

Whereas the goal of Olympism is to place sport at the service of the harmonious development of humankind, with a view to promoting a peaceful society concerned with the preservation of human dignity;

Whereas the Opening Ceremony for the 2024 Paris Olympics broadcast was viewed by 28.6 million viewers;

Whereas the USOPC recognized Michiganders that competed in Paris;

Whereas Heath Baldwin competed in track and field;

Whereas Bobby Body competed in para powerlifting;

Whereas Devin Booker competed in basketball;

Whereas Kate Brim competed in para cycling;

Whereas Adam Coon competed in wrestling;

7 ments at the 2024 Paris Olympics and Paralympics;

8 (3) recognizes the achievements of the players,
9 coaches, and support staff who were instrumental in
10 the United States victory; and

11 (4) honors the unifying nature of the Olympic
12 and Paralympic games and their role in promoting
13 a peaceful society concerned with the preservation of
14 human dignity.
