A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Terrorist Inadmis-
5 sibility Codification Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF HAMAS, PALESTINE ISLAMIC JIHAD,**
2 **HEZBOLLAH, AL-QAEDA, AND ISIS OFFICIALS**
3 **AND MEMBERS AMONG ALIENS ENGAGED IN**
4 **TERRORIST ACTIVITY.**

5 Section 212(a)(3)(B)(i) of the Immigration and Na-
6 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1182(a)(3)(B)) is amended, in the
7 undesignated matter following subparagraph (IX), by
8 striking “or spokesman of the Palestine Liberation Orga-
9 nization” and inserting “spokesperson, or member of the
10 Palestine Liberation Organization, Hamas, Palestine Is-
11 lamic Jihad, Hezbollah, Al-Qaeda, ISIS, or any successor
12 or affiliate group, or who endorses or espouses terrorist
13 activities conducted by any of the aforementioned
14 groups,”.

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
