Mr. MARSHALL introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions

A BILL

To require implementation of primary indicators of performance for certain programs of workforce investment activities.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Expedited Perform-
5 ance Indicator Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. IMPLEMENTATION OF PRIMARY INDICATORS OF**
7 **PERFORMANCE.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 6 months after the
9 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Labor (re-
10 ferred to in this Act as the “Secretary”) shall fully imple-

1 ment the requirements of section 116 of the Workforce
 2 Innovation and Opportunity Act (29 U.S.C. 3141), for
 3 programs described in subclauses (I) through (III) of sub-
 4 section (b)(3)(A)(ii) of that section 116 (referred to in this
 5 Act as “covered programs”), including—

6 (1) finalizing the objective statistical model de-
 7 scribed in subsection (b)(3)(A)(viii) of that section
 8 116, and using the model to calculate State adjusted
 9 levels of performance under subsection (b)(3) of that
 10 section 116, for covered programs; and

11 (2) establishing performance accountability
 12 measures, and applying reporting and evaluation re-
 13 quirements, and sanctions, under that section 116
 14 for covered programs.

15 (b) INAPPLICABILITY OF TRANSITION PROVISIONS.—
 16 Nothing in section 503 of the Workforce Innovation and
 17 Opportunity Act (29 U.S.C. 3343) shall be construed to
 18 permit any delay in, or any reduction in the scope of, the
 19 full implementation described in subsection (a).

20 **SEC. 3. INFORMATION AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.**

21 (a) MEETINGS.—Not later than 1 month after the
 22 Secretary publishes a notice in the Federal Register that
 23 the full implementation described in section 2(a) is com-
 24 plete, the Secretary shall hold monthly meetings with
 25 State boards to provide information and technical assist-

1 ance concerning the performance accountability measures
2 established in accordance with section 2, and related re-
3 quirements for States under section 116 of the Workforce
4 Innovation and Opportunity Act.

5 (b) CONTINUATION.—The Secretary shall continue
6 the monthly meetings with a State board until the Sec-
7 retary determines that the State has received the informa-
8 tion and technical assistance necessary to carry out the
9 State’s requirements under that section 116.

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
