Mr. PETERS (for himself and Mr. COTTON) introduced the following bill;
which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To require all high-mobility multipurpose wheeled vehicles of the Army to be equipped with an anti-lock brake system and electronic stability control kit, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ANTI-LOCK BRAKE SYSTEM AND ELECTRONIC**
4 **STABILITY CONTROL KIT FOR CERTAIN ARMY**
5 **VEHICLES.**

6 (a) REQUIREMENT.—By not later than September
7 30, 2033, the Secretary of the Army shall ensure that all
8 high-mobility multipurpose wheeled vehicles of the Army

1 are equipped with an anti-lock brake system and electronic
2 stability control kit.

3 (b) PLAN.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after
5 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
6 of the Army shall submit to the congressional de-
7 fense committees a plan to carry out subsection (a).

8 (2) ELEMENTS.—The plan required under
9 paragraph (1) shall include each of the following:

10 (A) A description of the steps required to
11 increase production of anti-lock brake systems
12 and electronic stability control kits and retrofit
13 high-mobility multipurpose wheeled vehicles at
14 Red River Army Depot, Texas, and its associ-
15 ated flyaway teams.

16 (B) An identification of any challenges to
17 meeting the requirement under subsection (a)
18 and a list of steps required to address those
19 challenges.

20 (C) An estimated monthly rate of retrofits
21 needed to meet the requirement under sub-
22 section (a).

23 (D) A funding plan for carrying out the
24 steps referred to in subparagraphs (A) and (B).

1 (E) An identification of any authorities or
2 funding required for any secondary destination
3 transportation necessary to carry out the plan.

4 (c) ANNUAL CERTIFICATION.—Not later than each of
5 March 1, 2025, March 1, 2026, and March 1, 2027, the
6 Secretary of the Army shall certify to the congressional
7 defense committees that the budget of the Army will en-
8 able the Army to meet the requirement under subsection
9 (a).

10 (d) CONGRESSIONAL DEFENSE COMMITTEES DE-
11 FINED.—In this section, the term “congressional defense
12 committees” has the meaning given that term in section
13 101(a)(16) of title 10, United States Code.

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
