1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That, in recognition of Sergeant Edgar Brian
3 Torres-Tovar and Sergeant William Nathaniel Howard,
4 who served with distinction in the 1st Squadron of the
5 113th Cavalry Regiment of the Iowa National Guard,
6 their remains shall be permitted to lie in state in the ro-
7 tunda of the Capitol on a date to be determined by the
8 President pro tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of

1 the House of Representatives, and the Architect of the
2 Capitol, under the direction of the President pro tempore
3 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Represent-
4 atives, shall take all necessary steps for the accomplish-
5 ment of that purpose.
