A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to withhold apportioned surface transportation funding from a State if such State fails to enact certain prohibitions relating to the use of automated license plate readers, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Federal License-
5 Plate Observation and Camera Keeping Act” or the “NO
6 FLOCK Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. WITHHOLDING OF FEDERAL FUNDS.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 1 of title 23, United
3 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
4 lowing:

5 **“§ 180. Requirements relating to automated license**
6 **plate readers**

7 “The Secretary shall withhold 10 percent of the
8 amount required to be apportioned to any State under sec-
9 tion 104(b) on the first day of each fiscal year that begins
10 after the second fiscal year beginning after the date of
11 enactment of this section if the State does not have a law
12 in effect that prohibits the use of automated license plate
13 readers for any use other than the following:

14 “(1) Enforcing toll systems.

15 “(2) Identifying stolen vehicles, missing or en-
16 dangered persons, vehicles registered to persons with
17 a warrant for a felony offense, or investigating a ve-
18 hicle involved in a felony offense.”.

19 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The analysis for chap-
20 ter 1 of title 23, United States Code, is amended by add-
21 ing at the end the following:

“180. Requirements relating to automated license plate readers.”.

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
