1 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR**
2 **MAUMEE RIVER, OHIO, MULTIPURPOSE**
3 **PROJECT.**

4 (a) NEW STUDY.—The Secretary of the Army is au-
5 thorized to conduct a feasibility study for the project iden-
6 tified as the “Glass City Riverwalk” in the report titled
7 “2026 Report to Congress on Future Water Resources
8 Development” submitted to Congress pursuant to section
9 7001 of the Water Resources Reform and Development
10 Act of 2014 (33 U.S.C. 2282d) for the purposes identified
11 below in subsection (b).

12 (b) PROJECT PURPOSES.—The feasibility study au-
13 thorized by subsection (a) shall be for a project along the
14 Maumee River, Ohio, in the vicinity of Glass City
15 Riverwalk, City of Toledo, Ohio, for flood risk manage-
16 ment, including riverbank stabilization, ecosystem restora-
17 tion, and recreation.

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
