Mr. WIED (for himself, Mr. TIFFANY, Mr. COLLINS, Mr. TIMMONS, Mr. EDWARDS, Mr. HARIDOPOLOS, Mr. HARRIGAN, Mr. MCCORMICK, Mr. NEHLS, and Mr. MCGUIRE) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To direct the Attorney General to identify and publish a list of anarchist jurisdictions, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Anarchists From
5 Endangering Cities Act” or the “SAFE Cities Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. IDENTIFICATION OF ANARCHIST JURISDICTIONS.**

7 (a) PUBLICATION.—Not later than 14 days after the
8 date of enactment of this Act, and updated not less than

1 every 180 days thereafter, the Attorney General, in con-
2 sultation with the Secretary of Homeland Security and the
3 Director of the Office of Management and Budget, shall
4 publish on the Department of Justice website a list identi-
5 fying each anarchist jurisdiction.

6 (b) CONSIDERATIONS.—In identifying whether a
7 State or unit of local government is an anarchist jurisdic-
8 tion, the Attorney General, in consultation with the Sec-
9 retary of Homeland Security and the Director of the Of-
10 fice of Management and Budget, shall consider, as appro-
11 priate, whether a jurisdiction—

12 (1) has a policy or practice that prevents or re-
13 stricts a law enforcement agency from intervening to
14 restore order amid widespread or sustained violence
15 or destruction;

16 (2) has prevented a law enforcement agency
17 from policing a geographical area or structure that
18 law enforcement officers are otherwise lawfully enti-
19 tled to police, except in the case of a tactical deci-
20 sion to temporarily withhold law enforcement offi-
21 cers that is intended to resolve safely and expedi-
22 tiously a specific and ongoing unlawful incident pos-
23 ing an imminent threat to the safety of individuals
24 or law enforcement officers;

1 (3) has disempowered or defunded a law en-
2 forcement agency; or

3 (4) unreasonably refuses to accept offers of law
4 enforcement assistance from the Federal Govern-
5 ment.

6 (c) GUIDANCE.—Not later than 30 days after the
7 date of enactment of this Act, the Director of the Office
8 of Management and Budget shall issue guidance to the
9 heads of Federal agencies on restricting eligibility of, or
10 otherwise disfavoring, to the maximum extent permitted
11 by law, anarchist jurisdictions in the receipt of Federal
12 grants that the agency has sufficient lawful discretion to
13 restrict or otherwise disfavor anarchist jurisdictions from
14 receiving.

15 (d) ANARCHIST JURISDICTION DEFINED.—In this
16 Act, the term “anarchist jurisdiction” means a State or
17 unit of local government that has refused to take reason-
18 able steps to stop acts of violence and destruction of prop-
19 erty in that jurisdiction.

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
