## AN ACT

To amend title VII of the Social Security Act to provide for a single point of contact at the Social Security Administration for individuals who are victims of identity theft.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Improving Social Security’s Service to Victims of Identity Theft Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. SINGLE POINT OF CONTACT FOR IDENTITY THEFT**  
5 **VICTIMS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Title VII of the Social Security  
7 Act (42 U.S.C. 901 et seq.) is amended by adding at the  
8 end the following:

9 **“SEC. 714. SINGLE POINT OF CONTACT FOR IDENTITY**  
10 **THEFT VICTIMS.**

11 “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Commissioner of Social Security shall establish and implement procedures to ensure  
12 that any individual whose social security account number  
13 has been misused (such as to fraudulently obtain benefits  
14 under title II, VIII, or XVI of this Act, or in a manner  
15 that affects an individual’s records at the Social Security  
16 Administration, or in a manner that prompts the individual to request a new social security account number)  
17 or whose Social Security card has been lost in the course  
18 of transmission to the individual has a single point of contact at the Social Security Administration throughout the  
19 resolution of the individual’s case. The single point of contact shall track the individual’s case to completion and coordinate with other units to resolve issues as quickly as  
20 possible.
