A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code to exclude certain
damages from gross income.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Lejeune Untaxed Com-
5 pensation and Settlements Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. CAMP LEJEUNE JUSTICE ACT DAMAGES EXCLUDED**
7 **FROM GROSS INCOME.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 104(a) of the Internal
9 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph 5, by striking “and” at the
2 end,

3 (2) by redesignating paragraph (6) as para-
4 graph (7), and

5 (3) by inserting after paragraph (5) the fol-
6 lowing new paragraph:

7 “(6) the amount of any damages received in an
8 action brought pursuant to the Camp Lejeune Jus-
9 tice Act of 2022; and”.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
11 this section shall apply to damages received after the date
12 of enactment of this Act.

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
