A BILL

To repeal the Human Rights Sanctuary Amendment Act

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “D.C. Shield Law Re-
5 peal Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF HUMAN RIGHTS SANCTUARY AMEND-**
2 **MENT ACT OF 2022.**

3 The Human Rights Sanctuary Amendment Act of
4 2022 (D.C. Law 24–257) is hereby repealed, and any pro-
5 vision of law amended or repealed by such Act is restored
6 or revived as if such Act had not been enacted into law.

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
