Mr. BACON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Defense to provide senior officials of the Department of Defense with secure mobile phones, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Defense Secure Mobile
5 Phones Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. SECURE MOBILE PHONES FOR SENIOR OFFICIALS**

7 **AND PERSONNEL PERFORMING SENSITIVE**
8 **FUNCTIONS.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Beginning not later than 90 days
10 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of

1 Defense shall ensure that each wireless mobile phone the
2 Department of Defense provides to a senior official of the
3 Department or any other employee of the Department who
4 performs sensitive national security functions, as deter-
5 mined by the Secretary, and all related telecommuni-
6 cations services are acquired under contracts or other
7 agreements that require the enhanced cybersecurity pro-
8 tections described in subsection (b).

9 (b) PROTECTIONS DESCRIBED.—The enhanced cy-
10 bersecurity protections described in this subsection en-
11 hanced cybersecurity protections for wireless mobile
12 phones and related telecommunication services that in-
13 cludes—

14 (1) encryption of data on the wireless mobile
15 phones and of all telecommunications to and from
16 the wireless mobile phones through such tele-
17 communication services;

18 (2) capabilities to mitigate or obfuscate per-
19 sistent device identifiers, including periodic rotation
20 of network or hardware identifiers to reduce the risk
21 of inappropriate tracking of the activity or location
22 of the wireless mobile phones; and

23 (3) the capability to continuously monitor the
24 wireless mobile phones.

1 (c) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the en-
2 actment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense shall submit
3 to the congressional defense committees a report con-
4 taining—

5 (1) a list of the contracts or other agreements
6 entered into pursuant to subsection (a);

7 (2) the criteria used by the Secretary to deter-
8 mine which employees of the Department of Defense
9 performs sensitive national security functions for the
10 purposes of subsection (a), and the total number of
11 such employees; and

12 (3) the total costs of wireless mobile phones and
13 telecommunication services required by subsection
14 (a).

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
