A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to exclude certain combat zone compensation of certain servicemembers relating to remotely piloted aircraft from gross income.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Remotely Piloted Air-
5 craft Crews Tax Relief Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXPANSION OF COMBAT ZONE COMPENSATION EX-**
2 **CLUSION.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 112 of the Internal Rev-
4 enue Code of 1986 is amended in subsections (a) and (b)
5 by inserting “including the operation of a remotely piloted
6 aircraft when such aircraft is in a combat zone and the
7 provision of intelligence, targeting, or command and con-
8 trol that is certified by the Secretary of Defense to be in
9 direct support of such operation,” after “served in a com-
10 bat zone,” both places such term appears.

11 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
12 this section shall apply with respect to compensation re-
13 ceived in taxable years ending after the date of the enact-
14 ment of this section for periods of active service after such
15 date.

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
