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## A BILL

To amend the Puyallup Tribe of Indians Settlement Act of 1989 to clarify that amounts in the Puyallup Tribe of Indians Settlement Trust Fund may be withdrawn by the Puyallup Tribe of Indians, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Helping Our People  
5 Act of 2026” or the “kʷaxʷad tiit ʔiišədčəł Act of 2026”.

1 **SEC. 2. WITHDRAWAL OF TRUST FUND BY PUYALLUP TRIBE**  
2 **OF INDIANS.**

3 (a) PERMANENT TRUST FUND FOR TRIBAL MEM-  
4 BERS.—Section 6(b) of the Puyallup Tribe of Indians Set-  
5 tlement Act of 1989 (Public Law 101–41; 103 Stat. 87)  
6 is amended by adding at the end the following:

7 “(6) Amounts in the trust fund may be withdrawn  
8 by the Tribe pursuant to the American Indian Trust Fund  
9 Management Reform Act of 1994 (25 U.S.C. 4001 et seq.)  
10 under a management plan approved by the Secretary  
11 under that Act.”.

12 (b) SAVINGS PROVISION.—The Puyallup Tribe of In-  
13 dians Settlement Act of 1989 (Public Law 101–41; 103  
14 Stat. 83) is amended by adding at the end the following:  
15 **“SEC. 14. SAVINGS PROVISION.**

16 “Nothing in this Act prevents the United States from  
17 engaging with the Tribe, on the same basis as other feder-  
18 ally recognized Indian Tribes, under any Federal law en-  
19 acted after the date of enactment of this Act.”.

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
