A BILL

To prohibit the provision of funding to the State of Minnesota until certain reporting requirements pertaining to voting are satisfied.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Minnesota Voter Integ-

5 rity Act of 2026”.

6 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON FUNDING.**

7 None of the funds authorized to be made available

8 under the Help America Vote Act of 2002 may be made

9 available to the State of Minnesota until the Minnesota

1 Secretary of State submits to the Attorney General the
2 following information:

3 (1) All records supporting or documenting
4 same-day voter registrations, as authorized under
5 Minn. Stat. 201.061, Subd. 3.

6 (2) All records for the votes cast by voters reg-
7 istered under Minn. Stat. 201.061, Subd. 3.

8 (3) All records kept under Minn. Stat. 201.01,
9 Subds. 7 and 8.

10 (4) Any other records the Attorney General de-
11 termines to be relevant to compliance with require-
12 ments under the Help America Vote Act of 2002.
