Mr. MILLS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

A BILL

To establish a reserve fund for the United States Capitol Police, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “United States Capitol
5 Police Reserve Fund Act of 2026”.

6 **SEC. 2. UNITED STATES CAPITOL POLICE RESERVE FUND.**

7 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—There is established a fund,
8 to be titled the “United States Capitol Police Reserve
9 Fund”, for the payment of salaries of employees and nec-
10 essary expenses of the United States Capitol Police during

1 a lapse of appropriations for the United States Capitol Po-
2 lice.

3 (b) USE OF THE FUND.—The Chief of the Capitol
4 Police, under the approval of the Capitol Police Board,
5 may use amounts from the United States Capitol Police
6 Reserve Fund only to make payments of salaries of em-
7 ployees and necessary expenses of the United States Cap-
8 itol Police after the start, and before the end, of a lapse
9 in appropriations with respect to the United States Capitol
10 Police.

11 (c) APPROPRIATION.—There is hereby appropriated,
12 out of money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,
13 \$50,000,000 for the United States Capitol Police Reserve
14 Fund.

15 (d) DEPOSIT OF APPROPRIATED FUNDS INTO THE
16 FUND.—The Secretary of the Treasury shall deposit
17 amounts appropriated under this section to the United
18 States Capitol Reserve Fund.

19 (e) RELEASE OF FUNDS TO THE TREASURY.—Not
20 later than January 31, 2027, the Chief of the Capitol Po-
21 lice shall transfer any amounts not used for the purposes
22 described in subsection (b) remaining in the United States
23 Capitol Reserve Fund as of December 31, 2026, to the
24 Secretary of the Treasury, and such amounts shall be re-
25 scinded.

1 (f) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 30 cal-
2 endar days after the date of compliance with subsection
3 (e), the Chief of the Capitol Police shall submit to the ap-
4 propriate congressional committees a report on the uses
5 of, and the transactions relating to, the United States
6 Capitol Reserve Fund.

7 (g) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES.—
8 In this section, the term “appropriate congressional com-
9 mittees” means the following:

10 (1) The Committee on House Administration of
11 the House of Representatives.

12 (2) The Committee on Rules and Administra-
13 tion of the Senate.

14 (3) The Committee on Appropriations of the
15 House of Representatives.

16 (4) The Committee on Appropriations of the
17 Senate.

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
