Mr. HERNÁNDEZ (for himself, Mr. SOTO, and Mr. GOLDMAN of New York) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Army to conduct a comprehensive assessment of the water and wastewater infrastructure modernization needs of Puerto Rico, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Puerto Rico Water
5 Infrastructure Resilience Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CORPS OF ENGINEERS REPORT ON WATER INFRA-**
2 **STRUCTURE NEEDS IN PUERTO RICO.**

3 (a) ASSESSMENT.—Not later than 180 days after the
4 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary, in consulta-
5 tion with the Puerto Rico Aqueduct and Sewer Authority
6 and any other relevant local and Federal agencies, shall
7 conduct a comprehensive assessment of the water and
8 wastewater infrastructure modernization needs of Puerto
9 Rico.

10 (b) REPORT.—Upon completion of the assessment de-
11 scribed in subsection (a), the Secretary shall submit to
12 Congress a report that includes—

13 (1) a description of the current condition and
14 vulnerabilities of water infrastructure in Puerto
15 Rico;

16 (2) the status of ongoing and planned projects
17 in Puerto Rico authorized under section 219 of the
18 Water Resources Development Act of 1992 (Public
19 Law 102–580), including any delays or gaps in
20 project execution;

21 (3) a description of water infrastructure mod-
22 ernization needs of Puerto Rico to enhance resilience
23 against future natural disasters, droughts, and sys-
24 tem failures; and

1 (4) recommendations for improving coordina-
2 tion across Federal and local agencies to accelerate
3 project delivery in Puerto Rico.

4 (c) SECRETARY DEFINED.—In this section, the term
5 “Secretary” means the Secretary of the Army, acting
6 through the Corps of Engineers.
