A BILL

To authorize the construction of a community-based outpatient clinic in Georgetown, Texas, as a major medical facility project of the Department of Veterans Affairs for fiscal year 2027, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Georgetown VA Com-
5 munity-Based Outpatient Clinic Authorization Act of
6 2026”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF COMMUNITY-BASED OUT-**
2 **PATIENT CLINIC IN GEORGETOWN, TEXAS, AS**
3 **A MAJOR MEDICAL FACILITY PROJECT OF**
4 **DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs
6 may carry out a major medical facility project in fiscal
7 year 2027 in Georgetown, Texas, that consists of the con-
8 struction of a new community-based outpatient clinic in
9 an amount not to exceed \$96,448,066.

10 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
11 authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary of Veterans
12 Affairs for fiscal year 2027 or the year in which funds
13 are appropriated for the Construction, Major Projects ac-
14 count, \$96,448,066 for the project authorized in sub-
15 section (a).

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
