## A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of Homeland Security from admitting to the United States any national of the People’s Republic of China without a valid visa, and for other purposes.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “One Nation, One Visa  
5        Policy Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON VISA-FREE ADMISSION OF CHI-**  
2 **NESE NATIONALS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Secu-  
4 rity shall not admit any national of the People’s Republic  
5 of China, or any individual bearing a passport issued by  
6 the People’s Republic of China, who is not in possession  
7 of a valid visa.

8 (b) PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS.—No funds ap-  
9 propriated or otherwise made available to the Department  
10 of Homeland Security may be used to allow the participa-  
11 tion of any national of the People’s Republic of China in  
12 the Guam and Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana  
13 Islands Visa Waiver Program authorized by section 212(l)  
14 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
15 1182(l)), including the Economic Vitality & Security Trav-  
16 el Authorization Program, or any other program that au-  
17 thorizes the admission of nationals of the People’s Repub-  
18 lic of China without a valid visa.

19 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

20 (1) IN GENERAL.—Except as otherwise explic-  
21 itly provided, a term used in this section shall have  
22 the meaning given such term in the immigration  
23 laws.

24 (2) IMMIGRATION LAWS.—The term “immigra-  
25 tion laws” has the meaning given the term in section

1 101(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8  
2 U.S.C. 1101(a)).

3 (3) PEOPLE’S REPUBLIC OF CHINA.—The term  
4 “People’s Republic of China” includes the Special  
5 Administrative Unit of Hong Kong and the Special  
6 Administrative Unit of Macau.
