Mr. RISCH (for himself and Mr. CRUZ) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

## A BILL

To abolish the United States African Development Foundation.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “United States African  
5       Development Foundation Dissolution Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. ABOLITION.**

7       The United States African Development Foundation  
8       established under section 503 of the African Development  
9       Foundation Act (title V of Public Law 96–533; 22 U.S.C.  
10      290h–1) is abolished.

1 **SEC. 3. REPEAL.**

2 The African Development Foundation Act (title V of  
3 Public Law 96–533; 22 U.S.C. 290h et seq.) is repealed.

4 **SEC. 4. TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS AND AUTHORITIES.**

5 (a) TRANSFERS TO SECRETARY OF STATE.—There  
6 are transferred to the Secretary of State all of the func-  
7 tions of the United States African Development Founda-  
8 tion, as of the day before the date of the enactment of  
9 this Act, including any unexpended balances, assets, or re-  
10 sponsibilities of such agency under any statute, reorga-  
11 nization plan, executive order, or other provision of law.

12 (b) NO RETENTION OF OFFICERS.—Nothing in this  
13 subsection (a) may be construed to require the reappoint-  
14 ment of any officer of the United States African Develop-  
15 ment Foundation as of the day before the date of the en-  
16 actment of this Act.

17 **SEC. 5. REFERENCES.**

18 Beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act,  
19 any reference in any statute, reorganization plan, execu-  
20 tive order, regulation, agreement, determination, or other  
21 official document or proceeding to the United States Afri-  
22 can Development Foundation, or to the President and  
23 Chief Executive Officer or any other officer or employee  
24 of the United States African Development Foundation,

1 shall be deemed to refer to the Secretary of State or the  
2 Department of State, as appropriate.
