Ms. HASSAN (for herself and Mr. CORNYN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs

A BILL

To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to authorize State and local cybersecurity grants for fiscal year 2026, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “State and Local Cyber-
5 security Grant Program Reauthorization Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. FEDERAL SHARE.**

7 Section 2220A(m)(1) of the Homeland Security Act
8 of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 665g(m)(1)) is amended—

9 (1) in subparagraph (A)—

1 (A) in clause (iii), by striking “and” at the
2 end; and

3 (B) by adding at the end the following:

4 “(v) for fiscal year 2026, 60 percent;
5 and”; and

6 (2) in subparagraph (B)—

7 (A) in clause (iii), by striking “and” at the
8 end;

9 (B) in clause (iv), by striking the period at
10 the end and inserting “; and”; and

11 (C) by adding at the end the following:

12 “(v) for fiscal year 2026, 70 per-
13 cent.”.

14 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

15 Section 2220A(r)(1) of the Homeland Security Act
16 of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 665g(r)(1)) is amended—

17 (1) in subparagraph (C), by striking “and” at
18 the end;

19 (2) in subparagraph (D), by striking the period
20 at the end and inserting “; and”; and

21 (3) by adding at the end the following:

22 “(E) for fiscal year 2026, \$300,000,000.”.

23 **SEC. 4. TERMINATION.**

24 Section 2220A(s)(1) of the Homeland Security Act
25 of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 665g(s)(1)) is amended by striking

- 1 “September 30, 2025” and inserting “September 30,
- 2 2026”.
