Mr. SULLIVAN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

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## A BILL

To amend the Controlled Substances Act to extend the limitations period for certain offenses resulting in death or serious bodily injury.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Timely Investigation  
5       and Maximum Enforcement for Overdose Justice Act” or  
6       the “TIME for Overdose Justice Act”.

7       **SEC. 2. LIMITATIONS.**

8       Section 401(b) of the Controlled Substances Act (21  
9       U.S.C. 841(b)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
10      lowing:

1       “(8) Notwithstanding section 3282 of title 18, United  
2 States Code, an indictment may be found or an informa-  
3 tion instituted at any time without limitation for any viola-  
4 tion of subsection (a) described in paragraph (1) of this  
5 subsection, or conspiracy to commit a violation of such  
6 subsection (a) under section 406, if death or serious bodily  
7 injury results from the use of such substance.”.

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
