A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to increase flexibility in the transferability of Post-9/11 Educational Assistance, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCREASED FLEXIBILITY IN TRANSFERABILITY**
4 **OF POST-9/11 EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE.**

5 (a) ELIGIBILITY.—Subsection (b) of section 3319 of
6 title 38, United States Code, is amended by striking “at
7 least—” and all that follows through the period at the end
8 and inserting “at least six years of service in the uni-
9 formed services”.

1 (b) TIME FOR TRANSFER.—Subsection (f)(1) of title
2 38, United States Code, is amended—

3 (1) by striking “or (*l*)”; and

4 (2) by striking “only while serving as a member
5 of the Armed Forces when the transfer is executed”
6 and inserting “at any time”.

7 (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Such section is
8 amended—

9 (1) in subsection (g)—

10 (A) in paragraph (1), by striking “at least
11 —” and all that follows through “; or” and in-
12 serting “at least six years of service in the
13 Armed Forces; or”; and

14 (B) in paragraph (2)(A), by striking “at
15 least —” and all that follows through “; or”
16 and inserting “at least six years of service in
17 the Armed Forces; and”;

18 (2) in subsection (i)—

19 (A) by striking paragraph (2); and

20 (B) by striking the following:

21 “(1) JOINT AND SEVERAL LIABILITY.—”;

22 (3) in subsection (j)(2)—

23 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking the
24 semicolon and inserting “; and”;

25 (B) by striking subparagraph (B); and

- 1 (C) by redesignating subparagraph (C) as
- 2 subparagraph (B);
- 3 (4) by striking subsection (k); and
- 4 (5) by redesignating subsection (l) as subsection
- 5 (k).

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
