A BILL

To amend section 1030 of title 18, United States Code, to include conspiracy in the offenses and penalties relating to computer fraud.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Cyber Conspiracy Mod-
5 ernization Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PENALTIES FOR CONSPIRACIES TO VIOLATE SEC-**
7 **TION 1030.**

8 Section 1030(c) of title 18, United States Code, is
9 amended—

1 (1) by inserting “or a conspiracy” after “an at-
 2 tempt” each place it appears; and

3 (2) in paragraph (4)—

4 (A) in subparagraph (A)(i), in the matter
 5 preceding subclause (I), by striking “at-
 6 tempted” and inserting “attempt or a con-
 7 spiracy to commit an”;

8 (B) in subparagraph (B)(i), by striking
 9 “attempted” and inserting “attempt or a con-
 10 spiracy to commit an”;

11 (C) in subparagraph (E), by inserting “,
 12 conspires to cause,” after “attempts to cause”;
 13 and

14 (D) in subparagraph (F), by inserting “,
 15 conspires to cause,” after “attempts to cause”.

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
