A BILL

To amend the Trade Expansion Act of 1962 to require a deadline for publication of information contained in reports on findings of investigations relating to imports that impair national security, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Section 232 Public
5 Transparency Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DEADLINE FOR PUBLICATION OF INFORMATION**
2 **CONTAINED IN REPORTS ON INVESTIGA-**
3 **TIONS RELATING TO IMPORTS THAT IMPAIR**
4 **NATIONAL SECURITY.**

5 Subparagraph (B) of section 232(b)(3) of the Trade
6 Expansion Act of 1962 (19 U.S.C. 1862(b)(3)) is amend-
7 ed to read as follows:

8 “(B) Not later than 270 days after the date on which
9 an investigation is initiated under paragraph (1), or not
10 later than the date on which the report is submitted to
11 the President under subparagraph (A) with respect to that
12 investigation, whichever is earlier, the Secretary shall pub-
13 lish in the Federal Register any portion of that report that
14 does not contain classified information or proprietary in-
15 formation.”.
