## A BILL

To provide for limitations on judgments, awards, and compromise settlements under section 1304 of title 31, United States Code.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Drain the Slush Fund  
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. JUDGMENTS, AWARDS, AND COMPROMISE SETTLE-**  
2 **MENTS.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 1304 of title 31, United  
4 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
5 lowing:

6 “(e) No judgment, award, compromise settlement, in-  
7 terest, or costs shall be authorized for payments that arise  
8 out of a lawsuit or claim filed by the President or Vice  
9 President.”.

10 (b) **APPLICABILITY.**—This section, and the amend-  
11 ments made by this section, shall apply to any pending  
12 case or any cause of action arising on or after January  
13 20, 2025.
