Mr. SCOTT of Florida introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry

A BILL

To amend the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 to modify work requirements under the supplemental nutrition assistance program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Let’s Get to Work
5 Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. SNAP WORK REQUIREMENTS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 6(o) of the Food and Nu-
8 trition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2015(o)) is amended—

9 (1) in paragraph (2), in the matter preceding
10 subparagraph (A), by inserting “, or, in the case of

1 a parent or other member of a household with re-
 2 sponsibility for a dependent child, 6 months (con-
 3 secutive or otherwise),” before “during which”;

4 (2) in paragraph (3)—

5 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking
 6 clause (ii) and inserting the following:

7 “(ii) over 60 years of age;”;

8 (B) in subparagraph (C), by inserting
 9 “under 6 years of age” before the semicolon at
 10 the end;

11 (C) in subparagraph (G), by striking “or”
 12 at the end;

13 (D) in subparagraph (H), by striking the
 14 period at the end and inserting “; or”; and

15 (E) by adding at the end the following:

16 “(I)(i) responsible for a dependent indi-
 17 vidual; and

18 “(ii) married to, and resides with, an indi-
 19 vidual who is in compliance with the require-
 20 ments of paragraph (2).”; and

21 (3) in paragraph (6)—

22 (A) in subparagraph (B), by striking “(I)”
 23 and inserting “(H)”;

24 (B) in subparagraph (C), by striking “(G)”
 25 and (I)” and inserting “(F) and (H)”;

1 (C) in subparagraph (D), by striking “(G)
 2 through (I)” and inserting “(F) through (H)”;
 3 (D) by striking subparagraph (F);
 4 (E) by redesignating subparagraphs (G)
 5 through (J) as subparagraphs (F) through (I),
 6 respectively; and
 7 (F) in subparagraph (F) (as so redesign-
 8 nated), by striking “(C), (D),, (E), or (F)” and
 9 inserting “(C), (D), or (E)”.

10 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
 11 16(h)(1)(E)(ii)(I) of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008
 12 (7 U.S.C. 2025(h)(1)(E)(ii)(I)) is amended by striking “3-
 13 month period” and inserting “3-month or 6-month period,
 14 as applicable,”.

15 **SEC. 3. WORK REQUIREMENTS FOR PUBLIC HOUSING AND**
 16 **TENANT-BASED RENTAL ASSISTANCE.**

17 (a) PUBLIC HOUSING.—Section 3 of the United
 18 States Housing Act of 1937 (42 U.S.C. 1437a) is amend-
 19 ed by adding at the end the following:

20 “(e) WORK REQUIREMENTS FOR FAMILIES.—The re-
 21 quirements described in section 6(o) of the Food and Nu-
 22 trition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2015(o)) shall apply with
 23 respect to any individual who—

24 “(1) is a member of a family residing in a pub-
 25 lic housing dwelling; and

1 “(2) is not exempted from those requirements
2 under paragraph (3) of such section.”.

3 (b) TENANT-BASED RENTAL ASSISTANCE.—Section
4 8(o) of the United States Housing Act of 1937 (42 U.S.C.
5 1437f(o)) is amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(22) WORK REQUIREMENTS FOR FAMILIES.—
7 The requirements described in section 6(o) of the
8 Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2015(o))
9 shall apply with respect to any individual who—

10 “(A) is a member of a family receiving ten-
11 ant-based assistance; and

12 “(B) is not exempted from those require-
13 ments under paragraph (3) of such section.”.
