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## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Extending the life of the Joint Congressional Committee on Inaugural Ceremonies.

1       *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*  
2       *concurring),*

3       **SECTION 1. REAUTHORIZATION OF JOINT COMMITTEE.**

4       Effective from January 3, 2025, the joint committee  
5       created by Senate Concurrent Resolution 34 (118th Con-  
6       gress), to make the necessary arrangements for the inau-  
7       guration of the President-elect and the Vice President-  
8       elect of the United States, is continued with the same  
9       power and authority provided for in that resolution.

1 **SEC. 2. USE OF CAPITOL.**

2       Effective from January 3, 2025, the provisions of  
3 Senate Concurrent Resolution 35 (118th Congress), to au-  
4 thorize the use of the rotunda and Emancipation Hall of  
5 the Capitol by the Joint Congressional Committee on In-  
6 augural Ceremonies in connection with the proceedings  
7 and ceremonies conducted for the inauguration of the  
8 President-elect and the Vice President-elect of the United  
9 States are continued with the same power and authority  
10 provided for in that resolution.

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
