RESOLUTION

Acknowledging the third anniversary of Russia's further invasion of Ukraine and expressing support for the people of Ukraine.

Whereas, on February 24, 2022, Russia launched a full-scale, unprovoked, and illegal invasion of Ukraine, which followed Russia's illegal annexation of Crimea in 2014 and its illegal occupation of parts of the Donbas region in 2014;

Whereas the international community recognizes the sovereignty and full territorial integrity of Ukraine within the 1991 borders; and

Whereas the Ukrainian Armed Forces and the people of Ukraine have demonstrated a determined resistance that has prevented Russia from taking control of their country: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Senate—

2 (1) expresses continued solidarity with the peo-
3 ple of Ukraine and condolences for the loss of tens
4 of thousands of Ukrainian people to Russian aggres-
5 sion;

6 (2) rejects Russia’s attempts to militarily seize
7 sovereign territory in Ukraine and elsewhere in Eu-
8 rope;

9 (3) reaffirms the support of the United States
10 for the sovereignty and territorial integrity of
11 Ukraine;

12 (4) commends NATO, the Ukraine Defense
13 Contact Group, and the international community for
14 their continued efforts to support Ukraine’s defense
15 and the protection of human rights on its territory;

16 (5) supports Ukraine’s aspirations to integrate
17 into Euro-Atlantic structures;

18 (6) recognizes Ukraine’s efforts to strengthen
19 its democracy during wartime;

20 (7) encourages the transatlantic community to
21 continue to denounce Russia’s illegal and

1 unprovoked war in Ukraine and counter Russian ag-
2 gression; and
3 (8) emphasizes that Ukraine must be a partici-
4 pant in discussions with the Russian Federation
5 about Ukraine's future.

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
